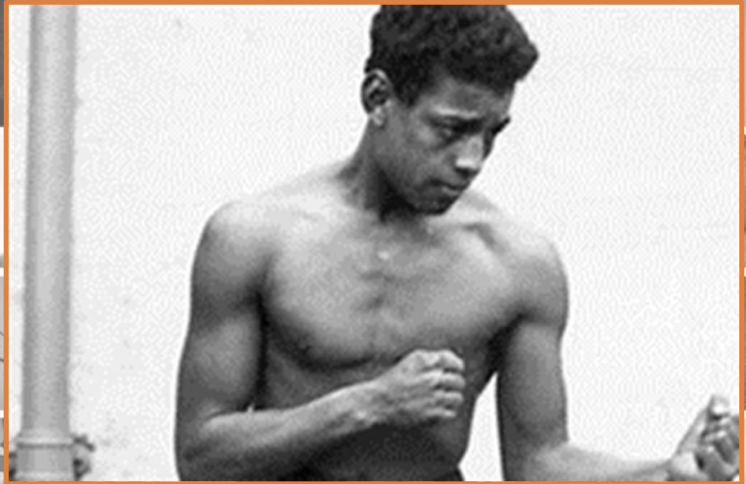


1. Len Johnson was the first black boxer to hold a major title during the British colour bar era, holding his title in which year?

3. The Twisted Wheel nightclub, famous for housing many northern soul nights where both black and white members of society enjoyed black music and hedonistic activities opened when?



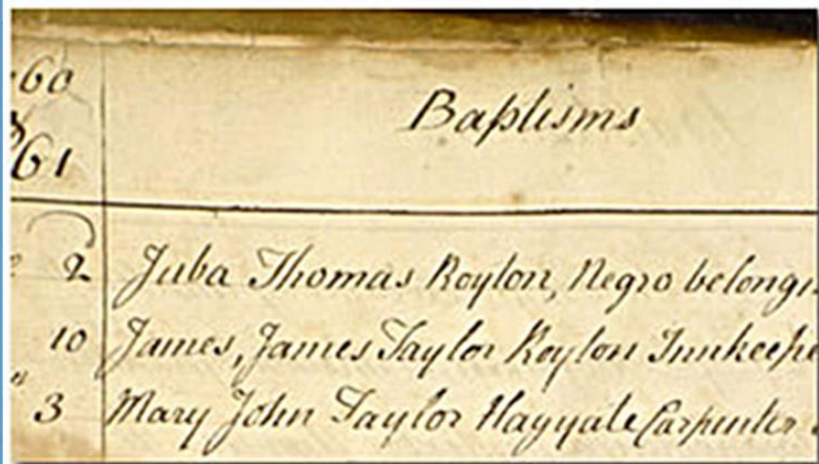
4. Manchester United player Dennis Walker, their first black player who signed as part of the 'Busby Babes' following the Munich air disaster, debuted in which year?





5. A degrading Statue of a Black man was removed from the grounds of Dunham Massey Hall near Altrincham, depicting a slave in which year?

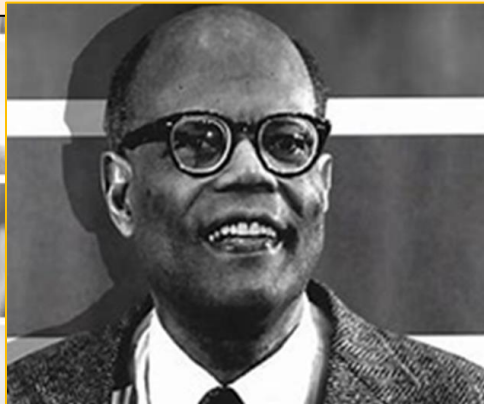
6. First registers of a Black man in Manchester (Oldham, Royton) was Juba Royton, who lived in that town. In which century?
