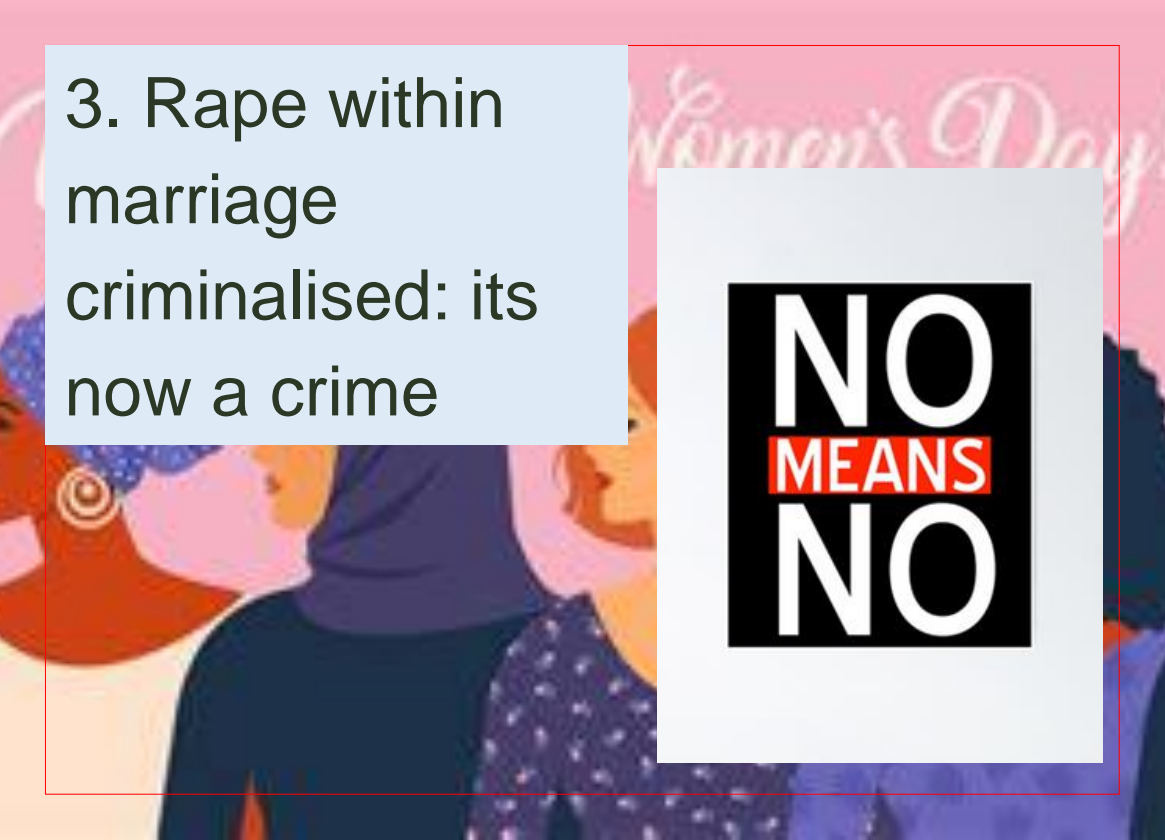

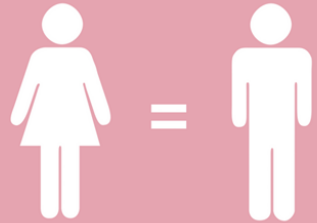

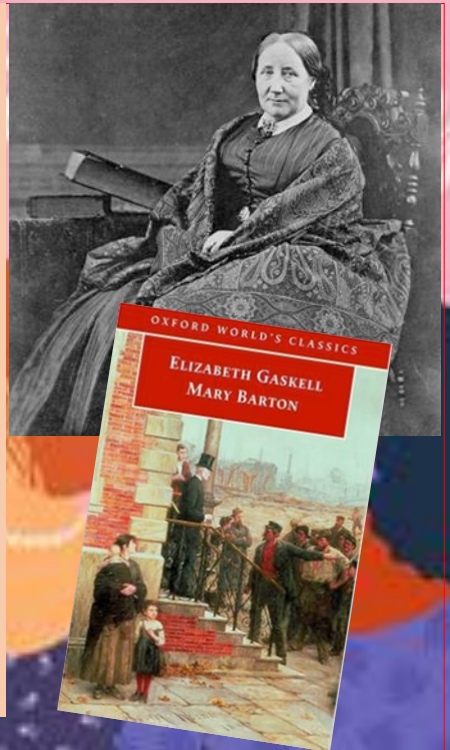

- (5) 1930 - Marie Stopes: First female academic of Manchester University & opened Britain's first birth control clinic
- (1) 1961 - Contraceptive Pill becomes available through NHS
- (3) 1991/1994 - Marital Rape, criminalised.
